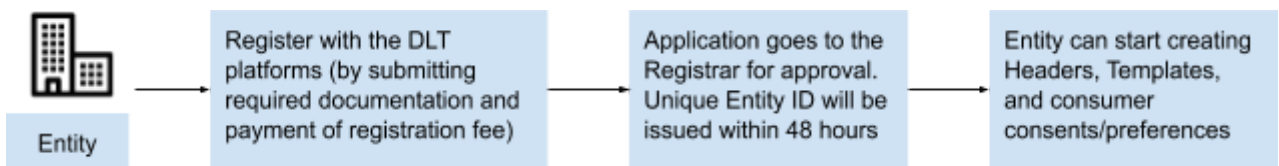


INDIA: Sender ID Registration Guide (Local Entities)

You will need to register your sender ID on all Indian network operators' DLT portals.

1. First Step

- a. Register: Principal Entity, Headers & Templates on the DLT portals for all operators

2. Documents required

No.	Document Checklist	Document Type
1	Self-certification by authorized signatory required on letterhead with name, designation and seal.	
2	Proof of authorized signatory (Authorization letter)	Scanned Image to be uploaded on the portal
3	Proof of Identity (Authorized signatory)	Scanned Image to be uploaded on the portal
4	POA :Proof of Address (as per Documentation Policy)	Scanned Image to be uploaded on the portal
5	Consent letter from parent entity (signed by both re-seller and PE, and on PE letterhead)	Scanned Image to be uploaded on the portal
6	Registration fee (Rs. 5000)-Deposit slip - This fee is non-refundable.	NEFT/ Cheque/DD
7	Security Deposit (Rs. 50000)-Deposit slip with DD/Cheque. This fee is refundable	NEFT/ Cheque/DD - Not applicable in case TM registering a PE
8	Service Agreement on Rs 100 stamp paper (signed by TM & airtel's circle Legal)for Resources	Scanned Image to be uploaded on the portal
9	Pan Number (Entity), GST Number(Govt.), Aadhaar Number of Authorized Signatory	To be entered on portal
